

## **Baggy Fish**

### **Materials:**

Paint brushes

Washable paint

Recycled newspaper

Paper towels

Yarn

Construction paper

Water containers

Sponges (optional)

Lunch bags

### **Instructions:**

1. Paint a lunch bag with washable paint, you may use a sponge or paintbrush.
2. Add an eye so the fish can see.
3. While the paint is still wet, lay a piece of yarn on the fish to create a mouth, the yarn will stick when the paint dries.
4. On plain paper, paint a watery home for your fish, you might paint waves, seaweed or other fish.
5. Lay your fish on the water scene flat to air dry.
6. Crumple newspaper and stuff your fish with it.
7. Tie the open end with yarn, fluff out the tail and lay your fish on its watery home.
