

Paper Bag Pumpkin Patch

Materials:

Crayons

Scissors

Glue

White paper

Recycled newspaper

Construction paper (optional)

Lunch bags

Instructions:

1. Use crayons to color the tops of paper lunch bags green or brown for pumpkin stems.
2. Color the rest of the bags in pumpkin colors.
3. Open up your colored bags and fill with lightly crumpled recycled newspaper.
4. Twist tops closed at the stem bottoms.
5. Make eyes, a nose, and a mouth for Halloween jack-o-lanterns, or cut facial features from construction paper.
6. Add paper cut vines and leaves to display.
