

Pocket Place Mats

Materials:

Cardboard

An old buttoned shirt

Fabric scissors

Chalk

Fusible webbing

Instructions:

1. Create pattern by cutting an 18 by 14 inch rectangle from a thin piece of cardboard.
2. Spread flat an old buttoned shirt and set pattern on top
 - Be sure to include a row of buttons and a pocket
3. Trace patten onto shirt with chalk.
4. Using fabric scissors cut along chalk line through the back of the shirt.
5. Fold under 3/8 of inch of fabric and press edges of both cutouts.
6. Lay back side of placemat wrong side up and set strips of fusible webbing on it.
7. Cover with mat top and iron according to the directions on the fusible webbing.
