

## Printed Memo Blocks

### **Materials:**

Colored duct tape

Scissors

Memo cube pad, memo filler sheets, or scrap paper cut into small squares

Ink stamps or Foamies craft foam

Plastic bottle caps

Double-sided tape

Ink pad

### **Instructions:**

1. Cut a strip of duct tape that measures 2 inches longer than the height of the stack of paper.
2. Lay the tape sticky side up on the table.
3. Take the stack and tap the sides against a flat surface.
4. Hold the stack on end and press one edge down onto the center of the tape.
5. Wrap the tape ends over the top and bottom of the stack, pressing down firmly to bind the paper.
6. Use more tape to cover the edge if needed.
7. Lift the top sheet of paper and cut the tape just above the second sheet so that the binding is flush with the top of the pad.
8. Now use the stamp (or cutout shapes from Foamies) and ink pad to print the design on the three untapped sides of the block.
