

Shooting Star

Materials:

Ruler

Pencil

Thin cardboard

Scissors

Square of purple felt

Square of red felt

Assorted colors of thin ribbon

Stapler and staples

Glue

Instructions:

1. Use the ruler and pencil to draw a medium sized 5 point star (about 3 inches across) on thin cardboard.
2. Draw a slightly smaller star.
3. Cut both shapes out of the thin cardboard.
4. Place the larger shape on top of the purple felt and lightly trace around it with a pencil and repeat this with the smaller shape on the red felt.
5. Cut both stars out of the felt.
6. Cut three 8-inch strands of one color ribbon and three 8-inch strands of another.
7. Gather all the ribbon in one hand, making sure that the ends are even, then staple them together once or twice across one end.
8. After laying the purple star down on the work surface, place the stapled end of the ribbons in the center of the star.
9. Now put glue on one side of the red star and center it on top of the purple star, so that the ribbon strands are glued securely in between the two stars.
10. When the glue has dried completely, carefully poke a small hole in the top of the star and thread a short piece of ribbon through it to make a hanging loop.
